

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

MEADWAY COLD CURE DENTINE:
USES:
Making temporary crowns, bridges and inlays in the dental laboratory.
(This material is not suitable for use in the oral cavity)
MIXING:
The Powder and Liquid are mixed to a creamy consistency and is ready for use when the material drips smoothly off the end of the spatula.
Mixing Ratios:
1.3 grams powder to 1.0ml of liquid
Care should be taken when mixing to ensure that no air is trapped.
CURING:
After the restoration has been "built up" it may either be left to cure atmospherically or in a "pressure pot" Although a "pot" could be used if desired to speed up the process.
The setting time in atmospheric conditions is 15-17 mins at 21 degrees c.
Liquid used: Meadway Rapid Repair Liquid.
WARNING: IN EXTREME RARE CASES MAY CAUSE SENTISATION BY SKIN CONTACT
